1. Verbal communication is higher quantity, more empathetic, more complete e.g. verbal instruction	Promote advantages.
2. Gathering and garnering supplies e.g. berries, seeds, donations, community support.	
3. Group processing materials and information more efficient e.g. catering; accounting.	
4. More effective when coordination is horizontal e.g. peer collaboration.	
5. Less hierarchy needed for control e.g. more collegiate.	
6. More multi-tasking capability e.g. minding while processing	
7. More effective at individualised despatching e.g. packing	
8. Take fewer risks while operating machines e.g. driving	
9. Less affinity for particular technologies e.g. computers, cars, aircraft. More objective technology decisions.	
10. Gestation - growing new units until independent e.g. duplication, induction, orientation, mentoring.	
11. More positive nurturing and caring for clients e.g. hospital patients, school children and male prisoners.	
12. More sense of attention and belonging e.g. maternal; reception; telephone.	
13. More persuasive: e.g. manipulative; face-saving; sales.	
14. Females are more effective participants in informal teamwork e.g. hospital emergency care.	
15. Egalitarian group decision-making - better consensus processes.
